DOCUMENTS REQUIRED

- Passport and any passports which expired during your UK residency.
- Pass certificate of Life in the UK test.
- Pass certificate of English language test.
- Birth, adoption and marriage certificates.
- Documents detailing any time spent outside the UK during your UK residency.
- A statement detailing your immigration history.
- Financial information, including bank statements.
- & more depending on your circumstances.

REQUIREMENTS

- You continue to meet the suitability requirements - good immigration history and acceptable criminal record
- You have been lawfully resident in the UK for a specified period of time. Usually this is 5 years, but it will depend on the type of visa you have held
- You must still be in a genuine relationship with your spouse/partner & intend to continue living together
- You have not spent more than 180 days outside the UK within any year of your qualifying period
- Combined income of at least £18,600
- You have English language skills to a minimum of level B1
- You have passed the Life in the UK test.

REASONS FOR REFUSAL

- Incorrectly completed application form
- Misunderstanding Home Office guidance
- Not providing enough evidence of cohabitation
- Too much time outside UK in qualifying period
- Not passing the Life in the UK/Language tests

Parent of a UK Child Indefinite Leave to Remain

- Birth, adoption and marriage certificates.
- Documents detailing any time spent outside the UK during your UK residency.
- A statement detailing your immigration history.
- Financial information, including bank statements.
- & more depending on your circumstances.

REQUIREMENTS

- You continue to meet the suitability requirements - good immigration history and acceptable criminal record.
- You have been lawfully resident in the UK for 5 years on a Parent visa.
- Your child is under 18, or, if they are now over 18, they must not be independent.
- Your child is a British citizen or settled in the UK.
- You are not in a relationship with the child's other parent.
- You continue to have sole or joint responsibility for child.
- You have not spent more than 180 days outside the UK within any year of your qualifying period.
- Can adequately support and maintain yourself.
- English language skills to a minimum of level B1.
- You have passed the Life in the UK test.

REASONS FOR REFUSAL

- Incorrectly completed application form.
- Misunderstanding Home Office guidance.
- Too much time outside UK in qualifying period.
- Not providing enough proof of relationship to child.
- Not passing the Life in the UK/Language tests.

Skilled Worker Indefinite Leave to Remain

REQUIREMENTS

- You continue to meet the suitability requirements - good immigration history and acceptable criminal record.

- You are still a Commonwealth citizen.
- You have not spent more than 180 days outside the UK within any year of your qualifying period.
- You can adequately support and maintain yourself.
- Depending on your nationality, you may need to meet certain English language requirements.
- You have passed the Life in the UK test.
- You are not applying more than 28 days before the expiry of your current visa.

REASONS FOR REFUSAL

- Incorrectly completed application form.
- Misunderstanding Home Office guidance.
- Too much time outside UK in qualifying period.
- Applying too early.
- Not passing the Life in the UK/Language tests.
